REMO IN PROGRESS

Targeting to foster regional exchange and improve the quality of working and learning mobility within initial VET, the REMO consortium has put a lot of work into the introductory research study in order to gain valuable feedback for the development of the REMO products from all main target groups. Work on quality process descriptions and the online platform has already started.

RESEARCH STUDY REPORT

Following a mixed methods approach using interview guidelines and questionnaires, research data of a total of 482 respondents out of all partner countries could be gathered, including the target groups of

initial VET learners, HR managers and persons responsible for mobility in VET schools, sending and hosting organisations as well as external stakeholders.

Guiding results could be driven, facing much interest but big challenges alike. The full research study report as well as an executive
